


# Raid Auto Clicker

## About Auto Clicker

Raid auto clicker is a Windows application the is compatible with Plarium play. It will allow the user to farm a selected stage for as long as the player wants to. This application shall also allow the player to have the option of selling the items at the end of each round.

## Status




The status section displays the status of the game and farming. If the game indicator is on red, it means that the game is not running, if it displays green it means the game is detected and the Auto-Clicker is ready for configuration.

## Parameters



The parameters section allows the player to determine how much energy they have in the game and how much energy the play wishes to use for farming. The stage energy is how much energy that the current stage requires to farm. The stage time is the average stage time that the player knows the stage will take to farm.

## Options



The option section allows the player to choose to close raid and / or turn off the computer after farming. The sell items shall sell the rewarded item after each stage. Do note, this does not apply to dungeons.

## Item Sell Settings

This section allows the player to calibrate mouse pointer settings for selling items. These settings can be saved after first calibration for future use. There are two settings that are required for each item sell windows.

## Start and Stop




The play button will start the farming process that will then minimize the auto clicker; at that point the game window must be in focus. The stop button will stop the farming process.

## Save and Load



The save button will allow the player to save the item sell settings for future use. The refresh button will load the save sell settings which is saved in Documents, so be sure not to delete the *“Clicker.cfg”*.

## How To User Auto Clicker



When using Raid Auto Clicker be sure the Raid is up and running or else the application will tell you that the game is not running and refuse to take parameters.

## Complete a Run



Complete the stage that you want to farm and take note of the stage time, remaining energy, and stage energy. These settings are required for farming both campaign and dungeons.

Do know that always add 5 second to the stage time because the application will not compensate for the computer performance that it is running on, even though I try my best to apply that optimization to the source code.

## Configure Item Selling



Select the option to sell items, this will unlock the item sell settings. Select the item to be sell at the end of the stage. Center mouse in the sell button then record the mouse X and mouse Y for that dialog box.



Do the same for the second item confirmation sell dialog and record the mouse X and mouse Y numbers. After then you can press the save button to save the settings.

Once all the required settings are entered and saved you can press the play button, the auto clicker will minimize then after select the game windows to put it in focus. The game will run and if there is an item it will be sold at the end of each round. Note that this item selling feature will not work in dungeons at the moment until Raid implement item selling in the future.

### Note: The Auto Click will only do its task when:

1. The game window is in focus
2. The game is running in full screen
3. The game window is in restore or maximize position and in focus
4. The item sell setting are correctly entered.
